2) APPLICABLE LAWS

- The Royal Decree 1720/2007, of December 21, which approves the Regulations for the development of Organic Law 15/1999, of December 13, on the Protection of Personal Data (RDLOPD), in what does not is repealed and does not contradict the legislation currently in force in the field of data protection.
- Law 34/2002, of July 11, on Services of the Information Society and Electronic Commerce (LSSI-CE).

Registration of Personal Data

In compliance with what is established in the RGPD and the LOPD-GDD, we inform you that the personal data collected by CADHOTEL, SA, through the forms extended on its pages will be incorporated and will be treated in our file for the purpose of to be able to facilitate, speed up and fulfill the commitments established between CADHOTEL, SA and the User or the maintenance of the relationship established in the forms that the User fills in, or to attend to a request or query from the latter. Likewise, in accordance with what is provided for in the RGPD and the LOPD-GDD, unless the exception provided for in article 30.5 of the RGPD is applicable, a record of processing activities is maintained that specifies, according to its purposes,

Legal Basis for the treatment

The legal basis for the processing of personal data is consent. CADHOTEL, SA undertakes to collect the express and verifiable consent of the User for the processing of their personal data for one or several specific purposes.

The User will have the right to withdraw their consent at any time. It will be as easy to withdraw consent as it is to give it. As a general rule, the withdrawal of consent will not condition the use of the Website.

On occasions in which the User must or can provide their data through forms to make inquiries, request information or for reasons related to the content of the Website, they will be informed if the filling of any of them is mandatory due to the fact that they are essential for the correct development of the operation carried out.

Categories of data

The categories of data that are treated in CADHOTEL, SA are only identifying data. In no case are special categories of personal data treated within the meaning of Article 9 of the RGPD.

Personal data retention period

Personal data will only be retained for the minimum time necessary for the purposes of its treatment and, in any case, only for the following period: The data will be kept for the time necessary to be able to provide our services or to respond to inquiries of users through the enabled forms., or until the User requests its deletion.

At the time the personal data is obtained, the User will be informed about the period during which the personal data will be kept or, when this is not possible, the criteria used to determine this period.

Purposes of the treatment

We detail below the purposes of the data treatments carried out:

CLIENT MANAGEMENT: Being able to provide the services contracted within the natural activity of each company and invoice them. The data provided will be kept as long as the commercial relationship is maintained or for the years necessary to comply with legal obligations.

MANAGEMENT OF POSSIBLE CUSTOMERS: Being able to send people with legitimate interest information related to our products and services by any means available, and invite them to events of interest. The data provided will be kept as long as you do not request the cessation of this treatment and will be collected prior express consent.

CADHOTEL SA

PERSONNEL SELECTION: To be able to manage all those CVs and other information provided by candidates for a job and to keep them informed of the different job vacancies that occur in our organization and/or clients who hire the personnel selection service. The data provided will be kept until a job is awarded or until the right of cancellation is exercised regarding this treatment (this period will not exceed one year). At all times the candidate can oppose or limit the scope of the processing of their data.

Recipients of the data

The User's personal data will not be shared with third parties.

In any case, at the time the personal data is obtained, the User will be informed about the recipients or categories of recipients of the personal data.

Personal Data of Minors

Respecting what is established in articles 8 of the RGPD and 7 of Organic Law 3/2018, of December 5, on Protection of Personal Data and guarantee of digital rights, only those over 14 years of age may grant their consent to the lawful processing of your personal data by CADHOTEL, SA. If it is a minor under the age of 14, the consent of the parents or guardians will be necessary for the treatment, and this will only be considered lawful to the extent that they have authorized it. If this is not the case, the legal representative must inform you when possible.

Rights derived from the processing of personal data

The User may exercise against the Controller the following rights recognized in the RGPD and Organic Law 3/2018, of December 5, Protection of Personal Data and guarantee of digital rights:

Right of access: It is the right of the User to obtain confirmation of whether or not CADHOTEL, SA is processing their personal data and, if so, to obtain information about their specific personal data and the treatment that CADHOTEL, SA has made or made, as well as, among others, the information available on the origin of this data and the recipients of the communications made or planned for them.

Right of rectification: It is the right of the User to modify their personal data that turn out to be inaccurate or, taking into account the purposes of the treatment, incomplete.

Right of deletion ("the right to be forgotten"): It is the right of the User, as long as current legislation does not establish the contrary, to obtain the deletion of their personal data when these are no longer necessary for the purposes for which they were collected or processed; the User has withdrawn his consent to the treatment and this does not have another legal basis; the User opposes the treatment and there is no other legitimate reason to continue with it; the personal data have been treated unlawfully; personal data must be deleted in compliance with a legal obligation; or the personal data have been obtained as a result of a direct offer of information society services to a minor under 14 years of age. In addition to deleting the data, the Data Controller,

Right to limitation of treatment: It is the right of the User to limit the treatment of his personal data. The User has the right to obtain the limitation of treatment when he contests the accuracy of his personal data; the treatment is unlawful; the Data Controller no longer needs the personal data, but the User needs it to make claims; and when the User has objected to the treatment.

Right to data portability: In the event that the treatment is carried out by automated means, the User will have the right to receive from the Data Controller their personal data in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format, and to transmit them to another data controller. Whenever it is technically possible, the Data Controller will directly transmit the data to this other controller.

Right of opposition: It is the right of the User to not carry out the processing of his personal data or to stop processing them by CADHOTEL, SA.

CADHOTEL SA

Right not to be the subject of a decision based solely on automated processing, including profiling: It is the right of the User not to be the subject of an individualized decision based solely on the automated processing of their personal data, including the creation of profiles, existing unless the legislation in force establishes otherwise.

Finally, the interested parties have the right to file a claim with the competent Control Authority (AEPD) in the event that the User considers that there is a problem or violation of current regulations in the form in which they are processing your personal data.

You can exercise the above rights by sending us a letter attaching a copy of a document that identifies you to our address or email (which appear at the beginning of this text).

4) PRINCIPLES APPLICABLE TO THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

The processing of the user's personal data will be subject to the following principles contained in art. 5 of the RGPD and in article 4 et seq. of the LOPDGDD:

Principle of legality, loyalty and transparency:

The consent of the user will be required at all times, with completely transparent information about the purposes for which the personal data is collected.

Purpose limitation principle:

Personal data will be collected for specific, explicit and legitimate purposes.

Data minimization principle:

The personal data collected will only be strictly necessary in relation to the purposes for which they are processed.

Principle of accuracy:

Personal data must be accurate and always up to date.

Principle of limitation of the conservation period:

Personal data will only be kept in such a way as to allow the identification of the user for the time necessary for the purposes of the treatment.

Principle of integrity and confidentiality:

Personal data will be treated in such a way as to guarantee its security and reservation.

Principle of proactive responsibility:

The person in charge of the Website will maintain and regulate the necessary technical and logistical means sufficient for all the principles applicable to the treatment to be met.

5) WHAT SECURITY MEASURES DO WE APPLY?

We apply the security measures established in article 32 of the RGPD, therefore, we have adopted the necessary security measures to guarantee a level of security adequate to the risk of the processing of the data we carry out, with mechanisms that allow us to guarantee confidentiality, integrity, availability and permanent resilience of treatment systems and services.

Some of these measures are:

- Information on data processing policies to staff.
- Carrying out periodic backups.

- Data access control.
- Regular verification, evaluation and assessment processes.

6) SECRET AND SECURITY OF PERSONAL DATA

CADHOTEL, SA undertakes to adopt the necessary technical and organizational measures, according to the level of security appropriate to the risk of the data collected, so as to guarantee the security of personal data and avoid destruction, loss or alteration accidental or illicit of personal data transmitted, stored or otherwise treated, or the unauthorized communication or access to such data.

The Website has an SSL (Secure Socket Layer) certificate, which ensures that personal data is transmitted securely and confidentially, as the transmission of data between the server and the User, and in feedback, fully encrypted or encrypted.

However, due to the fact that CADHOTEL, SA cannot guarantee the impregnability of the internet or the total absence of hackers or others who fraudulently access personal data, the Data Controller undertakes to communicate to the User without undue delay when there is a breach of the security of personal data that is likely to entail a high risk for the rights and freedoms of natural persons. Following what is established in article 4 of the RGPD, a breach of the security of personal data is understood as any breach of security that causes the destruction, loss or accidental or illicit alteration of personal data transmitted, stored or treated in another way, or the unauthorized communication or access to such data.

The personal data will be treated as confidential by the Data Controller, who undertakes to inform and guarantee by means of a legal or contractual obligation that this confidentiality is respected by his employees, associates, and any person to whom he makes it accessible the information.

7) LINKS TO THIRD PARTY WEBSITES
